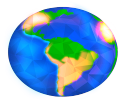


Week 2: We Love The Environment!

Activity 1: Ways I Love The Earth



① *This activity can be completed before the Zoom session if you have a university mentor.*

Pollution is when gases and chemicals are introduced into the environment in large amounts that make it harmful for humans, animals, and plants. For example, some causes of pollution are cars or garbage. There are many ways to keep our Earth clean and safe! In this activity, you can brainstorm some ideas to keep our Earth healthy and how you can make a positive impact to help the environment.

Materials: Coloured construction paper/white paper, Heart-shaped Earth cut outs, hole puncher, ribbon, markers/colouring pencils, glue, scissors



This craft requires cutting. It is important to be careful when you use scissors. Ask an adult to help you!

Directions:

1. Colour in and cut out the heart-shaped Earth.
2. Create a "Ways I Love the Earth Sign" that you can glue on in front of the heart.
3. Come up with some ways you can help the environment, e.g. "I recycle", then write the ideas on a circled piece of construction paper/white paper.
4. Hole-punch at the bottom of the heart and at the top of the circles.
5. Cut different lengths of string then tie the heart and the circles together at the holes so that it can hang.

Level Up! Reduce, reuse, recycle! Define the three words and think of how you can reduce, reuse, and recycle.

Activity 2: Earth Day Addition and Subtraction

① *This activity can be completed independently of the Zoom session if you have a university mentor.*

Work on your math skills while also drawing and colouring some fun earth-day related pictures!

Materials: Roll-Count-Colour worksheets, colouring crayons/markers, two dice

Directions:

1. Roll two dice and add the numbers.
2. Find the added number on the worksheet to colour it in.
3. Repeat but this time by subtracting the number from the two dice.
4. Keep adding and subtracting until all the pictures are coloured.



Level Up! Roll the two dice and draw pictures related to Earth Day and the added number. For example, if the dice have a sum of 3, then you can choose to draw 3 flowers or any other picture you think is related to Earth Day.

Activity 3: Earth Day Crossword

① *This activity can be completed independently of the Zoom session if you have a university mentor.*

Learn the meaning of environment related words while filling out a fun crossword!

Materials: Earth day crossword sheet, pen/pencil

Directions:

1. Figure out what the words are to complete the crossword by understanding the descriptions found at the bottom of the sheet.
